- With the passage of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 14, the fiscal year 2020 allotment for Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and the Capital Outlay (CO) of the Ministries and Offices are extended for obligation and disbursement until December 31, 2021.
- 2. For effective execution of the extended allotment, the Ministry of Finance, and Budget and Management shall issue a comprehensive guidelines. This will entail requiring submission of pertinent financial records from the Ministries and Offices.
- 3. Anent this, the Ministries and Offices are enjoined to submit the following documents for the period ending December 31, 2020, to wit:

Additionally, all Ministries and Offices are required to submit a comprehensive report on the status of the your existing bank accounts and detailing the balances as well as the updated ledger of transactions as of December 31, 2020. All Ministries/ Offices authorized to open other sub-accounts are enjoined to submit the same report per bank account.
- 5. All documents must be submitted on or before **January 15, 2021** at the MFBM.
